WELCOME TO YOUR RISE PRESCHOOL

At RISE, our mission for our schools derives from our belief that within every individual lies a natural curiosity and thirst for knowledge and it is our aim to awaken this curiosity in the early years and help keep it alive by providing quality education at every level.

Our main aim is to create a balance between preparing children for their academic life and simultaneously, life itself. We follow the British National Curriculum to prepare our children for their academic path in life, ensuring that they are ready and comfortable for whatever academic journey they may take. Simultaneously, however, we also place emphasis on life skills, helping to raise responsible, considerate, energetic members of a community ready to contribute positively to the world around them. We view every child, every student, every individual as a valued member of society and treat them as such.

Our approach at every RISE School, places great emphasis on developing Healthy Habits from a young age, increasing your child's chances of continuing these habits throughout their lifetime. Firstly, promoting healthy eating and a healthy lifestyle are a priority for us - a well balanced dietary plan and exercise becomes a part of your child's routine at school. Additionally, our schools participate in environmental awareness programs such as Eco Schools and LEAF which allow us the opportunity to introduce this important topic to our young students and encourage them to be environmentally friendly and live an eco-friendly lifestyle by practicing this during their time at school. Finally, at each Rise School, the concept of simply being a decent person is never, at any level, overlooked or undervalued. Respect, kindness and manners are a huge part of our environment and the idea of helping others and being considerate and caring to those around us are aspects of life that are touched upon every step of the way in our learning experiences.

Our Learning Approach is student centered. We focus on fulfilling the standards of the British National Curriculum in order to prepare the children for their further education but we work towards creating an environment that will allow each child the freedom to experiment with their preferred means of learning as it is our true belief that early years education is a time to learn how we like to learn. We aim to allow our students to learn through hands on experience and experimentation alternating between independent, teacher led and group based activities.

Finally, a significant factor of our schools is our interest in every child's uniqueness and our appreciation of every child's individuality. We base our plans for each child on their needs and abilities, not simply their age. Differentiation, we believe, is key to successful development and we strive for your child to reach their full potential with our enthusiastic guidance and assistance.




THE IMPORTANCE OF PARENT INVOLVEMENT

We encourage and welcome parent involvement and interest in our schools as we are very keen to create a sense of community.

Throughout the academic year we plan adventurous programs, excursions and educational visits for our students to enhance their learning experience and it is very often the case that parents are invited along to get involved too.

In addition, you are welcome to become part of our Parent Volunteers Group. This is a group that includes parents who work together with the educators and managers of the school during the school year to discuss issues surrounding our students as well as the children of the community. Together the Parent Volunteers Group creates plans to better improve the school for the benefit of the children as well as organise fundraising events, awareness campaigns and general events for the wider community.

With regards to communication, we aim for effective and positive communication with the parents of our schools. There are regular scheduled meetings between the class teacher and our children's parents to ensure that we are able to give you feedback on your child's progress as well as give you the chance to express any concerns, inform us of anything we should know or ask any questions.



OUR GOAL OF AN INCLUSIVE EDUCATIONAL ENVIRONMENT

All children develop at different paces and despite their age, have various levels of needs and abilities. We strive to provide each student with the support they need in order for them to reach their full potential.

Our schools work closely with a learning support team in order for any and all of the children's needs to be met for whatever reason. In addition, our schools include a Support Room as well as a SENCO among our on campus team who observes the children regularly. In the case that your child should require support, our SENCO offers their time and effort to assist in any way possible to ensure the most positive outcome.



REPORT FORMS

Progress Report Form

During the academic year you will receive a progress report form written by your child's teacher, tracking their progress according to the British National Curriculum. These report forms are followed by Parent Teacher meetings where you are given the opportunity to discuss your child's development with their teacher.

Daily Report Form


Using our online Parent Portals, each day you are able to login to see how your child was during the day and what they got up to in class (Note: Our Online School Portal also allows you to view calendar dates and communicate with members of staff at school).



OUR PROMOTION OF HEALTHY EATING

Each RISE school has a kitchen's license allowing us to provide a home made, healthy, well balanced lunch for our students during each day at school.

We promote healthy eating and therefore any meal plan we follow has been designed in collaboration with a nutritionist and has been prepared by our school caretaker on school premises using fresh and seasonal ingredients.



SAFETY

At each RISE school, safety is our first priority above everything else.

Each school includes up to date safety measures both indoors and outdoors, including security locks, entrance cameras and visitor checks.

In addition, our staff are trained and certified, each year, in CPR, BLS (Basic Life Saving) and First Aid as well as receiving Defibrillator Training as we have defibrillators on premises.

Furthermore, there are procedures and plans in place at each school for the unlikely event of a fire or earthquake. Drills are carried out during the year, including the children, so that if anything occurs, our staff, as well as the children, will be able to remain calm and organised.



HOW DO I ENROLL?

The enrollment process initially begins with a RISE Application Form that you are required to complete.

This form is then placed on to our waiting list and you will be contacted during an enrollment period. Prospective students who do not manage to enroll at our school during an enrollment period will remain on our waiting list to be contacted as soon as a space can be offered.

Once contacted to enroll at your chosen school, there will be a non-refundable enrollment fee of 230 euros along with the required forms as stated below, to be submitted. Once these have been received by the school, your child will be guaranteed a place for the following academic year.

At the beginning of every year there will be re-registration opportunities for your child to remain with us for the following academic year. All existing students receive priority and with a non-refundable re-registration fee of 130 euros to secure their place, are guaranteed a space for the following academic year.

Required forms for Enrollment:

- A completed Registration Form.
- A copy of your child's Birth Certificate.
- A copy of your child's passport (if applicable).
- A copy of parent/guardian ID's/Passports.
- A medical certificate from your child's Pediatrician to confirm that your child is in full health.
